I would like to give you a brief account of our charitable works for the year 2014 to 2015.

Apart from all this our major project is Jerome Home where we have 10 elderly inmates 3 sisters to see to them & a maid to see to the overall cleanliness of the home. The annual expense for the home is 3.5 to 4 lakhs approximately 30 thousand per month, which includes food, water, toilet, medicine TV/paper a nominal stipend for the sisters & salary for the maid.

We would like to thank our Parish Priest Rev Fr. Anthony Swamy for his co-operation, guidance and assistance in helping us to carry on our charitable activities.

We also thank Sr. Rose Mary from the Franciscan Sisters of the Immaculate & her juniors for the smooth running of the home.

Before I conclude, one request from you our parishioners, we like new members to join us. We are 15 members in all. The majority of us our senior citizens, some in the age group 80 to 90 plus, we need active members to join us to carry on the work of St. Vincent De Paul.
